Acceptance Fee

To secure enrolment for your children, a non-refundable fee is required upon acceptance. The fee for primary enrolment is \$750, while the fee for secondary enrolment is \$1,500.

Capital Levy

Each family is subject to a mandatory Capital Levy of \$1,500 annually, except those with only a Pre-Kindergarten student, who are exempt from this charge.

Account Payment

A single yearly statement is issued to each family during the latter part of January. All families must choose a payment plan to guarantee the full settlement of all fees by the conclusion of the academic year.

Withdrawal

As a prerequisite for registration, we require written notification of a student's withdrawal at least one full term in advance. Failure to do so will result in the payment of the full term's fee.

Financial Assistance

A fee discount scheme exists for holders of a Centrelink Health Care Card, certain Pensioner Concession Cards and Veteran Affairs Pensioner Concession Cards. Applications upon enquiry (excludes Pre-Kindergarten students)

Secondary Assistance Scheme

The State Education Department offers a Secondary Assistance Scheme for holders of the above named eligible cards. Holders may request an application form. Conditions apply.

Family Discount

Family discount applies to the number of students undertaking schooling at Newman College at the same time. The discount is applied in order of age, with the eldest student receiving the lowest discount. The discount does not apply to Pre-Kindergarten students or students obtaining a Health Care Card concessions. The discount is applied as a percentage of the Tuition Fee (only) as per the below table:

1st Child	Full Fee
2nd Child	10%
3rd Child	30%
4 or more Children	40% Discount for each Child

Program Specific Charges

When choosing secondary subjects and participating in extracurricular activities, please note that there may be additional fees. These fees can include subject-specific charges, outdoor education programs, Support Center fees, textbook expenses, and other costs that the College may incur on behalf of the students.

Optional Programs

Music Tuition:

In 2025, music tuition fees will be issued by semester, and payments will be made through a portal. More details will follow in January 2025. Payment for lessons is required upon confirmation of participation in the music lessons. This will be before the commencement of the lessons. If it is necessary to hire an instrument, the cost will be added to your College fee account. A Music Diary will be provided at no charge.

If you intend to discontinue music lessons, kindly provide one term's notice.

Tours - Sporting, Cultural, Academic:

To be eligible to participate in any college tours, students must have made full payment of college fees or established an authorised payment plan. Only after fulfilling this requirement can a student apply for enrollment in these programs.
